

Abu Dhabi GC ranked in world's top 100 courses

Abu Dhabi Golf Club, winner of this year's Middle East Golfer award for the Best Golf Club (overall), as well as the Best Golf Course in the Middle East, added more feathers to its cap when the host venue to the European Tour's Abu Dhabi Golf Championship was included in Golf World's worldwide Top 100 rankings.
