

Harradine reigns victorious after Men's Open playoff

I chael Harradine of Jebel Ali Golf Resorts & Spa recorded a gross 72 over the Earth course to accompany his first round score of 75 on Fire (147) to win the 2014 Men's Amateur Open sponsored by BMW AGMC last month.

Harradine, playing off a plus three handicap, stood in a tie for sixth place after Friday's first round, which was played over the Fire course, six shots behind the opening 69 of leader Ricky Dominguez. But on day two, his consistent play over the challenging Earth course saw him reel in Dominguez, who couldn't find the par he needed on the last hole to secure the title. In the playoff, Harradine made par on the second extra hole for the victory.

Craig Vance (149) edged out Bayhaan Lakdawala on a countback to claim third spot, while Tiago Lobo took the net title with a score of 143.
