



Pravets Golf Club Hosts Successful European International Mid Amateur Tournament




Pravets Golf Club has successfully hosted the 2014 European International Mid Amateur Championship. As it has come to be expected, Pravets was presented in magnificent condition for the 2014 edition of this important European Golf Association Event.

All 3 returned a score of 6 under par for the Championship. The 3 went down the challenging 10th hole in sudden-death and Koller made no mistake this time closing out Heath and Banzhaf with a solid par 4 to win the title.
