

Golfclub Gstaad-Saanenland

For the next morning, the "roller coaster ride" in the Golfclub Gstaad-Saanenland is on the program. Even the prospect of warming on opposite steep slopes and ravines makes it clear what awaits us here at 1,450 meters high. The ensemble, also designed by Harradine Sr., is situated in the midst of a highmoor declared as a nature reserve. It passes through needle-cut forest woodcuts and various slopes, the course runs up and down anyway.

The topography is also the unusual routing: on the front loop it has three par-5 tracks and therefore a par of 37, back out there for four more par-3 holes and a 18, which with 452 meters of white just as only "five" of the Backnine (Par 33) and thus screwed place standard at least to 70. Gstaad-Saanenland requires precision and sensitivity, the driver usually stays better in the bag.
