

## Hill Fires Four Straight Birdies at Qatar Masters

*Scottish golfer Calum Hill delivered a stunning display with four consecutive birdies during the Qatar Masters at Doha Golf Club.*



Scottish professional Calum Hill produced one of the standout moments at the Qatar Masters with a spectacular run of four consecutive birdies that captivated spectators at the Doha Golf Club.

The highlight came at the par-3 17th hole, where Hill delivered what the DP World Tour described as throwing “a dart” with his approach shot, continuing his remarkable birdie streak that began four holes earlier.

### Perfect Execution on Desert Course

Hill’s impressive sequence showcased the kind of precision required to score well on Peter Harradine’s challenging desert layout. The Doha Golf Club, which has served as the venue for the Qatar Masters since 1998, demands accuracy and strategic course management across its 27-hole design.

The 17th hole, where Hill capped his birdie run, represents one of the more demanding par-3s on the course. His ability to find the target with such precision during a pressure-filled tournament round demonstrates the level of skill that defines professional golf at the highest level.

### Building Tournament Momentum

Four consecutive birdies can significantly alter a player’s position on the leaderboard and provide crucial momentum during a tournament round. Such streaks often separate contenders from the field, particularly on courses where scoring opportunities must be maximized when they present themselves.

The Qatar Masters continues to be an important stop on the DP World Tour calendar, attracting international fields to compete in the challenging desert conditions. Hill's birdie barrage serves as a reminder of the exciting golf that unfolds when players find their rhythm on tour.
